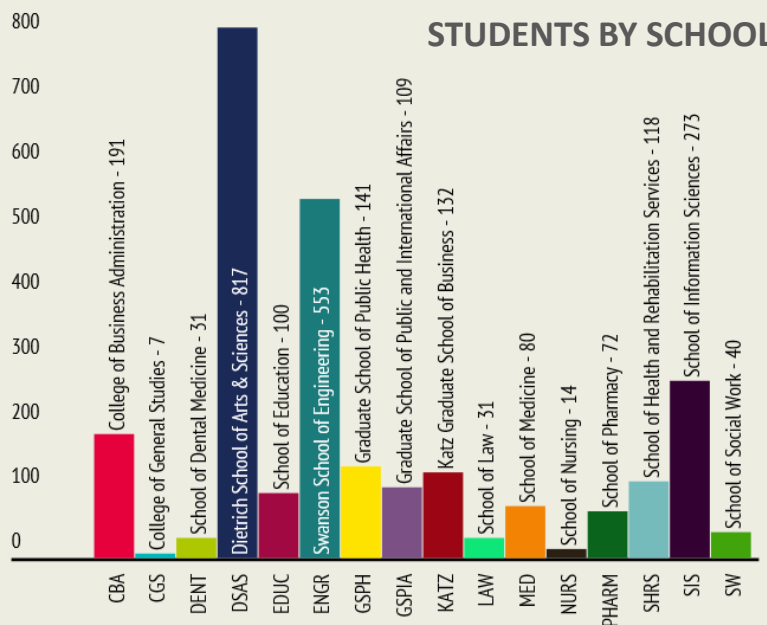


VISA TYPES



Other Sponsored Documents refers to international visitors in the Pitt community on documents of other organizations or family members.

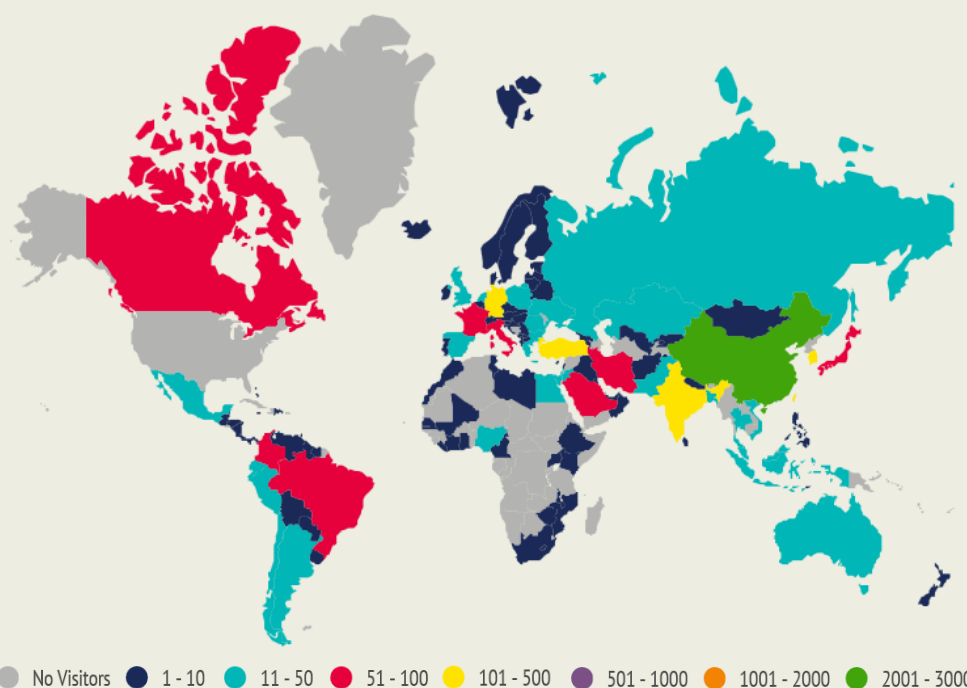
STUDENTS BY SCHOOL

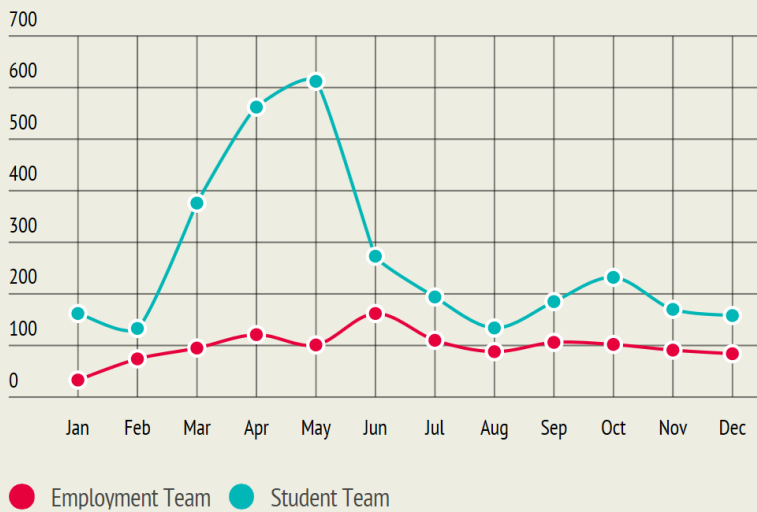

The type of casework for each team is quite different. The **Student Team** requests are for things like employment authorizations and program extensions. These requests are typically processed in 5 - 7 business days. The **Employment Team** requests are for scholars and employees and include initial applications for visa sponsorships as well as extensions. Because many of these requests require compliance with the Department of Labor procedures and timelines, they are more time intensive. Employment Team requests are typically processed in 5 - 30 days.

PROGRAMMING

Orientations - OIS presents tailored orientation session for international J-1 scholars, graduate students, and undergraduate students. These presentations are designed to help scholars and students understand all their immigration requirements, available Pitt resources, and cultural information to aid their transition to the United States.


Student Presentations - OIS will provide sessions on employment options for international students and specific programs at Pitt. In addition, the OIS staff regularly participates as Emerging Leaders facilitators and presents at the Panther Leadership Summit for undergraduate students.
